Jewellery Stolen From Mall Store

REGION OF PEEL: Investigators from the 22 Division Criminal Investigation Bureau are seeking the public's assistance in identifying two suspects responsible for the theft of jewellery, from the City of Brampton.

On April 8, 2018, at 3:39 p.m. two suspects attended a jewellery store inside of Shoppers World, located at 499 Main Street South, Brampton. Inside the store the female suspect distracted the employees, while the male suspect was able to reach over the counter accessing a secure case and

removed a number of jewellery pieces. Both suspects were able to leave the store and the employees noticed the theft shortly after the suspects left the store.

No weapons were seen or indicated and no one was injured in the incident.

Total value of items stolen is \$25,000.

Suspect #1: Male White, in his 30's, 5'10, shaved head, brown chin strap beard, gold aviator style glasses, gold necklace, black waist length jacket, navy blue t-shirt, blue jeans, and white running shoes

Suspect #2: Female, White, in her 30's, 5'8, black hair wore in a bun, dark rimmed glasses, grey puffy jacket with hood, green camouflage pants, and wearing brown boots.

Mosque Broken Into

REGION OF PEEL – Investigators from the 12 Division Criminal Investigation Bureau have arrested and charged a male responsible for a break and enter to a Mosque in Mississauga.

On March 14, 2018, police attended the Masjid Rahmatul-Lil-Alameen Mosque, located at 205 North Service Road in Mississauga. Police were advised that at approximately 10:30 p.m. a loud bang and noises were heard coming from the main floor of the Mosque. Upon investigating, it was noticed that an unsuccessful

attempt was made to pry open a door in order to gain access to a donation box.

On April 26, 2018, Ashraf Awada 58 year-old male from Toronto, was arrested and charged with Break and Enter with Intent to Commit an Indictable Offence, and with three counts of Breach of Probation Order. Investigators are encouraging any organizations to contact police if they have experienced a similar type incident.
