India on trading of pulses. Over the last three years, Canadian exports to India averaged over 2 million tons of pulses each year for an average value of \$1.2 Billion dollars/year. Pulse trade has been the economic driver in Canada's export business with India.

Canada accounts for more than one-third of global pulse trade. For many years, 50 percent of India's pulse imports came from Canada because Canada is a cost competitive supplier, and has the range of quality at the range of prices and pulse products that India has required.
