City Of Brampton Calls For Important Citizen Appointments

BRAMPTON: The City of Brampton is calling all residents looking to get involved in their city to apply for some important posts. The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton is seeking applications from citizens interested in various appointments for the 2018-2022 term of Council, ending in November 2022, or until a successor is appointed.

The City needs citizens for citizen-based Advisory Committees, Adjudicative Committees, Administrative Tribunals and related appointments as follows:
